In an effort to protect and safeguard our students all vehicles must have a parking permit placard displayed. Permits will be issued upon completion of this form and payment of a **\$5 fee** to the Controller for each permit to cover the cost of the placards. A separate registration form and fee is required for each vehicle. **NO ADDITIONAL PAPERWORK OR COPIES ARE REQUIRED.** Parking enforcement begins on Tuesday, September 2, 2014.

| Vehicle Parking Contract |

| <p>1. All vehicles must have current registration and insurance in accordance with the laws of the State of California and proof must be available in the vehicle at all times.</p> <p>2. All parking permits expire at 4:00 pm on the last day of instruction of a school year.</p> <p>3. Hours of parking permit enforcement are Monday through Friday 6:00 am to 4:00 pm except for enforcement of handicapped parking, parking in fire lanes, and rules pertaining to safe driving practices, which are enforced at all times.</p> <p>4. Parking permits are not considered valid unless they are displayed from the rear view mirror of the vehicle.</p> <p>5. A student parking permit limits parking to any stall designated for non-reserved student parking only. Parking in any location other than in a designated non-reserved student parking stall is prohibited and placing you subject to citation and/or other disciplinary consequences.</p> <p>6. Parking at Elk Grove High School is a privilege and may be revoked by administration for safety and/or disciplinary reasons.</p> <p>7. Violations of the EGHS Student Code of Conduct related to the use of your vehicle are in effect at all times. Such violations may result in a revocation of your parking permit as well as other disciplinary consequences. Examples of these violations include, but are not limited to, off campus parking, reckless and/or unsafe driving practices, and closed campus violations involving the use of your vehicle.</p> <p>8. Students who violate their provisional license restrictions (as outlined in section 12814.6 of the California Vehicle Code) will have their parking privileges revoked for the remainder of the school year.</p> <p>9. By entering our parking area the person driving any vehicle is deemed to consent to complete search of the vehicle including all its compartments and contents by school officials or law enforcement personnel, for any reason whatsoever. This notice applies to all vehicles of any type and is in force 24 hours a day.
